Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant from Stockholm enclosing a Report C.11 relating to a survey held at that port on the steamer "FREDRIKA", and with regard thereto, I have to inform you that when this ship was measured for freeboard assignment in 1919 the following sheers were reported, viz:-

Stem	91"
Sternpost	30 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
$\frac{1}{8}$ length from stem	51"
$\frac{1}{8}$ length from sternpost	17 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

As the sheers now reported appear to have been measured while the ship was trimming by the stern, I shall be glad if the Society's Surveyors at Stockholm will forward amended sheer figures with a view to reconciling them with the above sheers.
