With reference to my cablegram of the 21st January last and letter of the following day in reply to your cabled enquiry regarding the Swedish steamer "ELFSBORG", it is observed that this vessel is apparently running between New York and the West Indies, and I shall be glad to learn whether the Surveyors have ascertained if it is intended to complete at New York the survey for reclassification.

I may say that the steamer was partially surveyed for this purpose at Gothenburg in August last, and it was stated by the Surveyors in November that it was the Owners' intention to carry out the remaining requirements upon her return to Gothenburg in about three month's time from then.
