S. S. "CARMEN". Built 1902-2mo. 235 Tons Gross.

This vessel was originally classed 100A1, but the class was expunged with a Red Line in December 1925, the Second Special Survey No. 2, which became due in August 1924, not having been completed.

Lloyd's Agents at Las Palmas now state they have been approached by the Owners' Agents regarding the holding of the Periodical Survey, and they await instructions.

For the purpose of reinstating the class of this vessel in the Society's Register Book it would be necessary for the requirements of a Second Special Survey No. 3 to be held, including drilling of shell plating.

In view of the age of the vessel, and of the importance of the Survey, it is considered that this should be held by one of the Society's Exclusive Surveyors, and it is not considered that the Owners would wish to incur the expense of sending the vessel to a port where one of the Society's Exclusive Surveyors is stationed, or have a Surveyor sent to Las Palmas to hold the Survey.

It is submitted Lloyd's Agents be informed to the above effect.
