The Second Special Survey No. 2, which became due on this vessel in August 1924, was partly held at Las Palmas in October 1924.

The Classing Committee had the case before them in August last, when action was deferred on the understanding that the Special Survey would be completed and all necessary repairs effected at Las Palmas at the end of that month or during September.

In reply to further inquiry Lloyd's Agents at Las Palmas now state they are informed by the Owners that the vessel will not be submitted for the completion of the Special Survey, and in the circumstances, the Classing Committee, who had the case again before them on Tuesday, the 1st instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (12,25), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owners have been informed accordingly.
