Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "CARMEN", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case of this vessel before them, together with a communication received from Lloyd's Agents at Las Palmas.

In this case the Second Special Survey No.2 became due in August 1924, and in August last the Committee deferred action subject to the survey being completed and all necessary repairs carried out at Las Palmas at the end of that month, or during September.

It now appears, however, that you have advised Lloyd's Agents at Las Palmas that it is not your intention to complete the survey, and in the circumstances the Committee regret that they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned
