

TRANSLATION OF LETTER DATED THE 23rd. November 1943.

Dear Sirs,

In reply to your letter of the 13th.inst. regarding the "VINTE E OITO DE MAIO" I beg to inform you that this vessel has returned to the Colony of Cabo Verde leaving Lisbon on the 20th. inst. after effecting important repairs not however all those recommended by you owing to the urgency which the Colony of Cabo Verde manifested for the return of the steamer.

The vessel carries a sea worthy certiffate for six months and it is assumed that the vessel will return to Lisbon within this period in order to complete the repairs recommended and any others that may be found necessary.
