Dear Sirs,

With reference to the Special Survey No.3 which became due on the steamer "VINEE E OITO DE MAIO" at the end of January last, I beg to acquaint you that from a communication received from the Society's Surveyors at Lisbon, it is understood that the inspection in question will be carried out at Cabo Verde.

In the circumstances the Committee will be obliged if you will kindly arrange to appoint a competent and independent Surveyor to carry out this inspection, and forward his report to this office.

For the information of the Surveyor, I enclose sample reports together with an extract from the Rules, and forms for reporting the result of his inspection.

I may say that the Special Survey in question was partly carried out at Lisbon in August / November last, by the examination of the bottom, rudder, decks, hatch and vent coamings, steering gear and battening arrangements.

The enclosed documents should be returned to this office upon completion of the inspection, and I may say all fees and expenses are payable by the Owners, and should accordingly be charged by you to them.
