Dear Sir,

A. With reference to the Admiralty Trawlers "WILLIAM DOAK" and "HENRY CRAMWELL" I have to inform you that reports have been received from the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff from which it appears that the vessels have been sold before the re-conditioning surveys were entirely completed.

Reports of re-conditioning survey covering the work so far as it has been carried out in each case are enclosed herewith and in the circumstances a proportion only of the total fees agreed upon is chargeable, viz:- £16:16:0 in the case of the s.s. "WILLIAM DOAK", which was originally classed with the British Corporation and comes under the heading of paragraph (1) of your letter of the 30th November, 1920, and £14:14:0 in the case of the s.s. "HENRY CRAMWELL", which is already classed with this Society and comes under the heading of paragraph (2) of the letter above referred to.

I enclose herewith an account for the amounts in question and shall be glad to be favoured with a remittance in settlement at your convenience.
