The YOKOHAMA Surveyor
reports the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, and
the S.S. completed.

A length of chain cable
found worn below permissible limit requires to be renewed
at the earliest opportunity, and the Surveyor recommends
accordingly. (1)

12 tank side brackets (p.s),
3 tank side brackets (s.s) and horizontal bracket at aft
pillar foot (s.s) in No. 6 hold require to be repaired or
renewed.

It is recommended these
repairs be carried out at the next dry docking. (2)

It is submitted the vessel
appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey
6.41 and notation of S.S. No. 2-40, subject as now
recommended, (2 recommendations).
