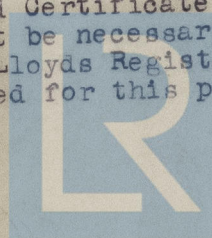

Referring to your communication No. 1807/13-7-49 enclosing a letter from Lloyds Register of Shipping regarding the tug "REVUE" I have the honour of advising you by communication No. 3673/142/S dated 26th. Sept. last on behalf of the Colony of Moçambique as follows:-

"With regard to communication No. 714/1V-M-7 of 16th. July last received from Military Director General of Colonies (Maritime Department) I have the honour to inform you that vessels in the service of State, as is the case of the tug "REVUE", a Freeboard Certificate issued by the Registration Society will not be necessary.

The services of Lloyds Register of Shipping will therefore not be required for this purpose."
