6 shackles of 1-1/8" diameter and 4 plate links successfully withstood a tensile stress of 9-1/8 tons.

These were stamped L.R. H.83. 13.9.39, 9-1/8 tons.

1 length of 56'-8" 7/8" diameter gypsy chain successfully withstood a tensile stress of 9-1/8 tons.

The chain was stamped L.R. H.83. 15.9.39, 9-1/8 tons.
