The class is subject to permanent repairs to indented plating and framing (s.s) in 2nd, 3rd and 4th strakes below upper deck sheer at the first convenient opportunity.

The KOBE Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, and on account of damage through striking wharf (see Kobe Rpt 11482) repairs effected to shell plating, frames, beams, and 1 tank top plate renewed.

Minor repairs effected.

The outstanding items, as above have now been dealt with.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 6.41 without special condition.
