Dear Sir,

With reference to your classing letter of the 25th inst., Leith Report No. 15674 "Sunbank" built by The Burntisland Shipbuilding Co. Ltd, Burntisland, and in reply thereto, I beg to state that the diameter of the rivets in the keel butts are ^{1 1/8} 1" and the rivetting of the inner bottom plating is as approved double rivetted throughout. The rivets in the treble rivetted butts of shell plating are spaced 3 3/8" apart as approved, and the rivets in the butts of the poop side plating are ^{3/4} 3/4" diameter spaced 2 5/8", the rivetting in the edge of the sheerstrake and the thickness of the forecastle side plating is as approved. I also enclose forging report as requested.

I beg to tender my regrets for the errors on the report.
