With reference to the Glasgow First Entry Report No. 39026 on the three boilers built by Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox Ltd. (No. 430), I have to inform you that the Society's Surveyors at Leith now report that these boilers have been fitted into the S.S. "SUNBANK" (ex "WAR BROSMA"), Messrs. The Burntisland Shipbuilding Co's No. 101 vessel.)

I enclose herewith for your information, a copy of a letter I have to-day addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Leith on the subject of the fees chargeable in this case, and in the event of Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox being liable for the fee due for the survey during construction at their works of the boilers, I shall be glad if you will kindly render an account to them for the proportion of the fee due, viz:-£17: 4: 9.

Should, however, Messrs. Douglas & Grant, the Engineers be liable for the whole of the fee for the Engines and Boilers, perhaps you will be good enough to advise the Society's Surveyors at Leith, in order that they may include the amount in their account to the Engineers.
