Dear Sirs,

S. I beg to acquaint you that Lloyd's Agents at St. Vincent have forwarded to this Office a copy of your letter of the 25th ultimo, addressed to them, respecting your steamer "PORTO GRANDE", from which it is noted that, in view of the circumstances of this vessel's service, you have decided not to proceed with the repairs and renewals enumerated in my letter of the 20th October last, addressed to Lloyd's Agents, to entitle her to retain her classification in the Society's Register Book.

In the circumstances I am directed to inform you that the Committee, who have had the case under consideration at their meeting today, have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a Black Line, indicating that, from reported defects, she is no longer eligible to retain her class.
