Dear Sirs,

I was duly favoured with your letter of the 15th instant respecting the S.S. "PORTO GRANDE", and with regard thereto I am directed to state it is noted that, while you require the freeboards to be assigned and marked in accordance with the provisions of the Merchant Shipping Act, you will not load the vessel to a greater mean draught than eight feet for the voyage to St. Vincent, and a memorandum giving particulars of the freeboards assigned is accordingly enclosed herewith.
