Onboard at the request of the master and owners' agents, The Union Steam Ship Co. of N.Z.

Wellington, to examine port boiler centre combustion chamber and boiler back plate for temporary

to enable the vessel to proceed to Shanghai or port of destination.

Port boiler centre combustion chamber wrapper plate cropped and plate welded. Combustion back plate cropped and plate welded and rivetted, 4 combustion chamber stays renewed. During process of fitting the new stays, it was found that the boiler back plate was cracked and this necessitated cutting back plate and fitting spigot patch in way of 4 stays and blowdown valve chest. back plate at bottom in way of outward flange, previous welding and crack cut out and rewelded.

This vessel has now been sold to new Owners, United Corporation of China, Shanghai,

Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:—
