Dear Sirs,

With reference to your first entry report No. 17493 on the S.S. "SAINT BEDE" (ex "WAR MINK") I have to inform you that an account has to-day been rendered to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the proportion of the fees due in respect of the construction of this Standard Vessel up to the time of transfer to private ownership, viz:- 25% of the difference of the fees on the Hull of the vessel chargeable at 1/4 per ton and the ordinary classification fees, and 50% of the difference of the fees on the machinery, as under:-

For survey of Hull.....	£16.	0.	0.
" " " Machinery.....	27.	0.	0.

I shall therefore be glad if you will see that the necessary entries are now made in your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
