on

Greek Steamer "TANAIS" - 1545 tons gross of Piraeus.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that, I, JOHN HAROULIS, Expert Diver, did, at the request of Captain M. PAPANGELIS, proceed to the Quay N°28, alongside which quay this vessel was lying, in order to examine the aft part underwater and report on same.

Early this morning I started my examination and found as follows:-

The main piece of rudder, the rudder itself and the rudder bolts were in good condition.

The sole piece of stern frame was found to be in good order except of the paint being slightly scratched.

The propeller was also found to be in good condition.
