With reference to your Classing letter of the 12th ultimo regarding the above named vessel, I beg to inform you that the condenser was examined at this port.

Referring to my statement 'So far as practicable' The cables and wiring used in the construction of this Electrical Installation were manufactured at Messrs. Hackenthal Draft & Kabel Werke A.G., Hanover, and, it is stated, are in conformance with the Greek Board of Trade requirements, and were, we are informed, the only cables available in this port.

The heavy armoured cable used for the Wireless circuit, is passed through the beam knees in the bunker space and the insulation of cable has an over all diameter of .875", and is not otherwise protested.

A plan of the installation with requested sizes of main cables, and circuit currents is herewith enclosed and has been signed by the Contractor.
