CERTIFICATE FOR THE CARRIAGE OF VEGETABLE OIL IN BULK.

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of

the owners, Messrs. The Nippon Yusen Kaisha survey the Deep Tank of the Twin Screw Steamer "TOYAMA MARU" 7090 tons gross of Tokio whilst the vessel lay afloat in Kobe Harbour from 23rd to 26th Feb. 1926.

The Deep Tank was tested by a head of water to the top of the air or overflow pipes 3 feet above weather deck, and upon examination, the boundary bulkheads, tank top, hatches, ventilators and other connections were found sound and tight.

No. 6 Double Bottom Tank in way of this Deep Tank was tested by a head of water to the top of the sounding pipes on the weather deck and found sound and tight.

The heating coils in the Deep Tank were tested to 250 lbs. per sq. inch, being about twice the working pressure, and found tight.

The Deep Tank was examined internally and is considered fit to receive a shipment of pec-nut oil in bulk subject to examination for cleanliness before loading.
