The 2 in No. reheating (réchauffeurs) coils after cleaning and examination were tested in place on Monday 10th January 1938 to 25 kilos cent, namely to double the working pressure.

Main pump (brûleurs), transfer (transfert) filters (filtres) hand (à bras) were after considerable renewals placed in an efficient working condition to my satisfaction.
