Nature of Survey _____

The Marseilles Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated, minor repairs effected and 15 fathoms of chain cable of proper size, weight and test placed on board.

An additional deep tank forward has been built in accordance with the approved plans for the carriage of vegetable oil.

An opening has been made in the bridge front bulkhead and steel doors fitted in accordance with an approved plan.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 11.31 and with notation of "Carrying vegetable oil in forward deep tanks".
