The class is subject to No.3 keel plate from aft and adjacent plating in A and B strakes, port side (set up) being repaired at the Owners' convenience.

The Havre Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated.

The plating, as above, examined and found efficient.

On account of damage through cause not stated, repairs have been effected to bilge keel.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 5,39, subject as above.
