I return herewith two copies of the amended plan, forwarded with your letter of the 8th instant, of pumping arrangement in the machinery space proposed by Messrs. Petters Ltd., for Messrs. Hawthorn Leslie & Co's Yard No.591, and have to acquaint you that this amended plan will be approved, provided the arrangements be as shown thereon, the remaining requirements of Section 34 of the Rules (1933-34) be complied with so far as they are applicable and all the work be done to the Surveyors' satisfaction.

It is concluded that the independent power pump will be arranged to draw from the sea and deliver water on deck, as required by Section 4, Clause 7 of the Rules for Engines and Boilers, but I shall be glad to learn if this is so.

The originally approved plan has been cancelled.
