Dear Mr. French,

I am favoured with your letter of the 6th instant, with reference to the cases of the s.s. "RED HOOK" and s.s. "HOBOKEN" (Seattle Reports Nos. 992 and 998 respectively), and carefully note what you say regarding the question of the assignment of the figure "1" to one of these vessels and the non-assignment to the other.

I have looked into the cases, and find that on the Report of the "RED HOOK" the American Committee's Minute, dated September 28, 1920, is 100A1, and that the minute on the Report of the "HOBOKEN", dated October 13, 1920, is 100A--.

We have simply followed the Minute of the American Committee in both cases, and I would suggest that you should bring the question before the American Committee and take their instructions in the matter.
