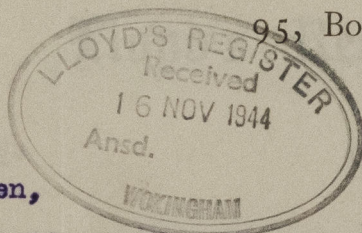

Dear Mr. Sladden,

I would confirm our telephone conversations regarding Greenock First Entry Report No. 22820 on the Motorship "EMPIRE RAWLINSON". In accordance with your advice, the case was submitted to the Glasgow Committee for a record of + L.M.C despite the fact that a screwshaft constructed under the survey of the British Corporation had been fitted.

Further, in accordance with your suggestion, I enquired of Mr. Akester, the Principal Surveyor at Greenock, whether the Builders would raise any objections to a November date of build being assigned in this case, and he later assured me that the Builders would have no such objection.
