I am in receipt of your letter of the 9th instant, with enclosures, respecting the M.V. "MAULY", and have to say it is noted that owing to defects ~~has~~ having developed in three original cast steel "A" frames of the main engines of this vessel it is proposed to replace these "A" frames with frames of all welded construction.

With regard thereto I have to acquaint you that Plan No.032158 advised in your letter showing welded "A" frames will be approved, provided the welding be carried out with approved electrodes to your satisfaction, and on completion of the welding the "A" frames be efficiently heat-treated.

I shall be glad if you will forward to this office a sketch showing particulars of the stated defects in the cast steel "A" frames.

One copy of the plan of welded frame is being returned to you under separate cover and the remaining plans are being retained in this office.
