H. I have to acquaint you that in September last the motorship "MAULY" was classed \* 100 A1 subject to the chain cables being placed in order.

It is observed from the shipping papers that this vessel arrived at Genoa on the 8th instant, and I shall be glad to learn how the above matter now stands.

I may add that in August last the Society's Surveyors at Trieste reported that four joining cable shackles did not appear to fit the windlass and it was stated that these would be replaced on the vessel's return from her contemplated voyage.
