Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th instant confirming the cablegrams between us respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steamer "SOLAAS".

The Committee are pleased to note that you have also altered your intention as regards the classification of the Steamer "STENSAAS", and as this vessel is not at present due for any Periodical Survey under the Society's Rules, they have given instructions for her character to be re-instated in the Register Book as desired by your goodself.

You will no doubt be aware that temporary repairs were effected to a sheerstrake plate at Leith in July, 1919, and it is recommended permanent repairs should be effected at this port at the first opportunity.

I may add that your remarks regarding the Steamer "MOLAND" now named "VARDAAS", recently completed by the Kalundborg Ship Yard, Denmark, are carefully noted.
