Dear Sirs,

With reference to your first entry report No. 6074 on the S.S. "MOLAND", I shall be glad if you will be good enough to state whether the moulded depth is 18'-2½" as reported by you, or 18'-8" as shown on the approved plan of midship section.

You should also state whether the sheerstrake is doubled at the ends of the bridge as approved, the rudder is constructed in accordance with the approved plan and can be unshipped afloat, the riveting of the poop, bridge and forecastle sides is as required by the Rules, and whether a hand pump or other efficient arrangement is provided for draining the fore peak flat.
