The original will be forwarded to Trinity House, but it is thought that it should be accompanied by a report from the Grimsby Surveyors.

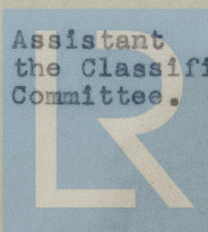
