Light House Tender "READY"

I duly received your letter of the 6th instant and have since learned from the Society's Principal Surveyor at Hull that the corrosion in this three year old ship is considered to be serious and is deserving of further investigation. I have therefore requested the Surveyors to endeavour to obtain samples of the affected plating, which is being removed, and to forward these to Mr. W. E. Lewis, the Society's Principal Surveyor for Metals at Glasgow, for examination and comment. The Surveyors have also been requested to obtain the fullest information available in regard to the original and subsequent coating of the bottom, and the history of the ship in service.

On receipt of Mr. Lewis's report I will write you further.
