With regard to the vertical donkey boiler, the Owners Representative states that the completion of the installation will be effected on the vessel's return to Blyth at the end of the six months guarantee period.

The 10 kW. Russell Newbury generator set has not been fitted on board, the Owners deciding to replace it by a 30 kW Paxman Ricardo generating set which was obtained from the Admiralty.

The Owners Superintendent stated that the 10 kW. Russell Newbury set has since been installed in an unclassified vessel - the First Entry Report No.12950 is returned herewith.
