the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Master and local agents examine the Twin Screw Steamer "EMPIRE PENRYN", 6345 tons gross of London while lying afloat at Swansea on the 9th August, 1948 and subsequent dates. The vessel is proceeding in ballast condition to West Hartlepool for repairs and completion of survey.

The main boilers, except the after port boiler which is not being used, were examined under steam and their safety valves adjusted to 215 lbs. per Square inch. The main and auxiliary machinery examined under working conditions and found in order for the contemplated voyage.

The vessel's class is subject to all outstanding recommendations previously made being effected before the vessel goes into service.
