This vessel formerly flew the Estonian Flag but, in August 1941 as the above mentioned surveys were overdue, a notation of "NO LATER SURVEY REPORTED" was assigned.

In February last she came under survey at Halifax N.S. on account of damage and it was recommended that permanent repairs be effected on the vessel's arrival at New York.

A letter dated the 22nd April last has now been received from Mr. Bennett to the effect that the vessel was then under repair at Baltimore and that the American Bureau Surveyors were in attendance. The Society's Surveyors had pointed out to the Master that the vessel was classed with Lloyd's Register but he stated this classification was no longer desired. This decision was also confirmed by the Amtorg Trading Company at New York.

It is understood the vessel is now owned by Sovtorgflot and is flying the Russian Flag.

In the circumstances the Deputy Chairman acting on behalf of the Classing Committee gave instructions on the 21st ultimo for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, 5,43, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
