I have to acquaint you I am advised by Messrs. Scheuer Bros. (London), Ltd., of this City that the steamer "DUDDINGSTON", No. 24020 in the Register Book, is now at your port where she is being transferred to the Estonian Flag. The new name is "OSMUSSAAR" and port of registry Tallinn.
