Dear Sir,

With reference to the enquiries contained in your letter of the 22nd instant regarding the freeboard report on the S.S. "DUDDINGSTON", I beg to inform you as follows, viz:-

1. The door to the poop companionway is capable of being manipulated from both sides. ✓
2. The shifting boards closing the openings of the forecastle and bridge after bulkheads are fitted the full height of the openings. ✓
3. The scupper and sanitary discharge pipes from the superstructure have storm valves fitted at the shell. ✓
4. The vent coaming 39" in height to the tunnel is not specially supported and it has now been arranged to reduce the height of this coaming to 36". ✓
5. A hand steering gear is fitted on the poop deck for emergency use in the event of a breakdown in the main steering arrangements.
