and confirm the following telegram sent in reply to-day:-

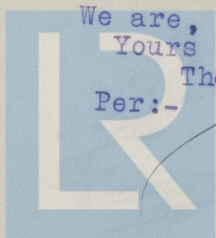
"Your wire steamer Duddingston builders


