Dear Sir,

With reference to the Surveyors' report of the freeboard survey of the s.s. "DUDDINGSTON", I shall be obliged if they will state:-

1. If the door to the poop companionway is capable of being manipulated from both sides.
2. If the shifting boards closing the openings of the forecastle and bridge after bulkheads are fitted the full height of the openings.
3. If the scuppers and sanitary discharge pipes from the superstructure have storm valves fitted at the shell and/or efficient traps at the inboard end.
4. If the vent 39" in height to the tunnel is specially supported.
5. If efficient provision is made for steering in the event of a breakdown in the main steering arrangements.
