Gentlemen,

I have to inform you that the Dutch Steamer "MAGDALENA" is stated to be at your port where the freeboard marking will be altered to comply with the Dutch law and to obtain the Dutch freeboard certificates which are enclosed herewith, together with the assignment letter and photo print showing the marking.

When the marking has been verified the Dutch certificates may be issued on payment of a fee of £2-2-0, being half the statutory fee, and in exchange for the British certificates previously issued, which should be returned to this Office with the usual verification of marking form and the Dutch assignment letter signed by the Surveyor who verified the marking.


