By this mail we are forwarding particulars and measurements as required on Report C11 for the steamer "BARUNGA", together with a letter received from the Owners stating that they require the freeboard for this vessel to be computed under the 1906 Rules.

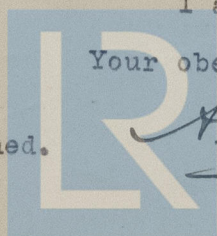
We beg to draw your attention to the length of the poop of this vessel which is shown in the Register Book as being 43 feet, whereas the extract of particulars taken from the original freeboard report gives this length as 29 feet 6 inches. The length of the poop has now been measured on the ship and found to be 29 feet 6 inches.

These remarks apply also to a sister vessel, S.S. "Baldina", the poop of which ship has also been measured and found to be 29 feet 6 inches.
