I have to report that the Society's Surveyor at Auckland has completed the Freeboard Survey of above vessel, surveyed for this purpose by me (Vide my Rpt C.11 No. 1503), by verifying the new freeboard marking on her sides and completing Rpt C.12(a). At his request, I issued International Load Line Certificate No. 2837 on New Zealand Form with Certified Copy to the Owners, Messrs. Union Steam Ship Co. of N.Z. Ltd., for which I received the necessary authority to issue, from the New Zealand Marine Department early in January but, as the vessel has been laid up in Auckland, nothing further was done till the present.
