Nature of Survey *Just entry*

It is submitted that before this case received the consideration of the Committee, the London Surveyors should be informed that this Tug has been towed ~~to~~ to Yarmouth for the fitting of her machinery, and to complete the survey for classification, the engine and boiler casings require to be refitted and riveted after the machinery has been fitted on board. They should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work to their satisfaction, to report upon the same on Form No.8 for the information of the Committee, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
