

POSTPONED SURVEYS.

On the 21st April last the Bombay Surveyors wrote stating the Owners were unable to submit this vessel for Special Survey then, as she was engaged in carrying food grain cargoes for Provincial Governments. The Committee approved extension until the end of August subject to a satisfactory General Examination being held. The vessel was drydocked at Bombay and a General Examination held in May/June with satisfactory results.

On the 24th ultimo the Bombay Surveyors wrote they were advised by the Owners that the vessel was expected to return from a voyage to Calcutta early this month, when outstanding surveys would be held.

The Calcutta Surveyors now cable asking if the Load Line Certificate may be further extended until the end of October, when it is stated the Special Survey will be held at Bombay.
