With reference to Yokohama First Entry Report No. 3093 on the S.S. "TATEISHI MARU" (The Yokohama Dock Co's S.S.No.96) I have to request that you will state:-

1. - The name of the Works at which the anchors were tested; and if the machine used has been examined and reported upon for the information of the Committee.
2. - Where the steel Works at which the cast steel rudder was made are situated, and whether these Works have been examined and approved. Also, the date when the rudder castings were tested and by whom.
3. - Whether the modification in the scantlings of the frames (shown on the back of the report) from those reported in the case of the sister vessel "SHIN-I MARU" have been approved by the Kobe Office.
