Survey Due Donkey Boiler Survey due 4.45.
Vessel's class is subject to the No. 1 cylinder unit of the main engine being repaired prior to her proceeding to sea.

In August 1945 consideration of this case regarding the carrying out of the Donkey Boiler Survey was deferred as it was understood the vessel was then on Special Service under the control of the U.S. Army Service Force.

The vessel came under inspection at San Francisco in January last when the above recommendation regarding No. 1 cylinder unit of the main engine was made. It was then stated that the vessel was to be laid up temporarily.

The New York Surveyors now state they have been informed by the W.S.A. that the vessel is still laid up on the Pacific Coast.

SUBMITTED action be deferred subject to the outstanding matters of survey being dealt with before the vessel is again placed in commission.
