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These three barges, which are owned by
the Southern Oil and Transport Corporation, were built in
1920 and are operated at Tampico.

They are classed "A- Barge for being
"towed. For Service on Panuco River. Carrying Petroleum in
"Bulk", and became due in April, May and July, 1924,
respectively, for First Special Survey No.1.

The Owners have now informed the Society's
New York Office that as they carry their own insurance on these
barges, they do not desire to continue them in the Society's
Classification.

In the circumstances the Classing Committee,
who had the cases before them on Tuesday, 9th instant, decided
to give instructions for the character of each vessel to be
withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...)
inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at
Owners' request.
