A memo dated the 2nd March, 1949 has been received from the Paris Office in reply to an enquiry respecting the classification of this vessel which states that she has is now classed with the Bureau Veritas.

This is submitted for the consideration of the COMMITTEE, in view of the SPECIAL SURVEY being 17 months overdue.
