Mr. Hogben, Deputy Chief Surveyor of the Board of Trade phoned requesting to be informed of the present situation regarding this vessel's condition.

It is understood she is still laid up in the River Blackwater.

As he was desirous of assessing the amount of repairs that might be required he was informed generally of the repairs and renewals carried out at the 4th S.S. No.3 in 1928, but that as the vessel had been laid up for an extended period no information could be provided as to her present condition.

He was further informed that the Committee had agreed to the vessel's class remaining undisturbed for the present on the understanding that she does not proceed to sea until the Special Survey and all the necessary repairs have been completed.
